Windows Support

Support has been added for Windows 11 in 8.6.0.

Enhancements

- #1669 Editing text blocks (e.g., geological descriptions): Edit text size now matches zoomed text size; F2 puts the selected text block into edit mode and positions the insertion point at the end; Alt+Enter inserts a line break.
- #1670 Verdana is now the default font for text layers in new logs.

Problems Fixed

- #1679 StarLog programs would occasionally fail to start and display an error message that the Windows OS version could not be determined.
- #1681 Exports of Color Fill or Symbol Fill layers from log files with depth scales of 1:20, 1:48 (25"=100') or 1:50 could sometimes skip data at certain depths.
- #1685 Some log files have a corrupt custom symbol in a symbol library. The symbol cannot be edited due to its bad format and once saved with StarLog v8.6.0, the log file cannot be re-opened and usually displays error message Diagram/293 "bad allocation". Corrupt symbols are now fixed and v8.6.0 logs with these symbols will open.
- #1690 The Save Changes prompt was still displayed after selecting "Always Save Changes".
- #1672 Right clicking in the track headings of some logs would cause a coordinate overflow error message.
- #1674 Selecting a graphic (e.g., text block, symbol, image) at one end of a log and using the Home or End key to move to the other end of the log triggered a redraw loop in some logs.

Compatibility

This version can open earlier log files. Versions 8.6.1 and newer of the same program can open log files saved by this version.
